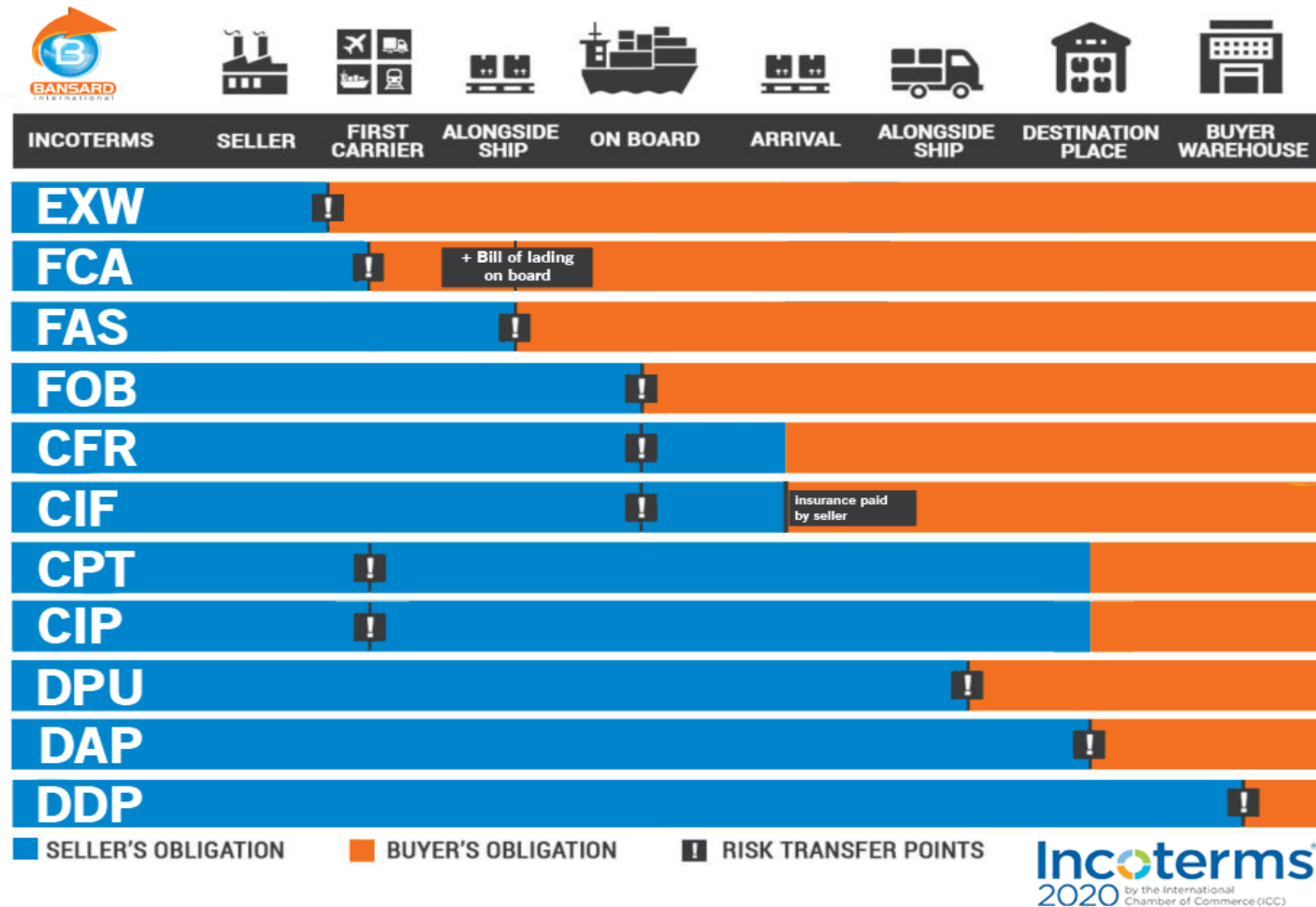


International Economic Law
